## Advisory

National Plant Protection Division, Argentina has allowed the export of Indian mango to Argentina with the following phytosanitary requirements:

The Phytosanitary Certificate (CF) of origin which must include

- In the field "Additional Declaration"
   The consignment has undergone a quarantine irradiation treatment at origin and is free from: Bactrocera caryae, Bactrocera correct, Bactrocera cucurbitae, Bactrocera dorsalis specis complex, Bactrocera zonata and Sternochetus mangiferae.
- 2. In the "Treatment" field: specify a 400 gy dose
  - In addition, it must have an Irradiation Certificate with the following information: Dose requested and absorbed, date of irradiation, traceability of the irradiation process, irradiation batch, Dosimeter used (batch).

Exporters are advised to fulfill the above requirement for export of mango to Argentina.
